Dear Parishioners.

I will be helping to lead a pilgrimage to the Holy Land from October 2nd through the 13th. Part of my duties in leading a pilgrimage is to bring to the holy sites the prayer intentions of those who are staying behind. I will be praying during the pilgrimage that our Lord will show me where he wants me to leave them. I look forward to you joining me on this pilgrimage by giving me your prayers to take to the Holy Land.

Pilgrim Passport update
Church of the Holy Spirit is
one of 17 parishes in the
Lincoln Diocese who are
on the Pilgrim Passport list.
The pilgrimages began

mid-August, and is where people can make a person pilgrimage to different churches in the diocese which offer Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We have a sign-in register near where the passport stamp is, so that CHS parishioners and visitors can get their booklet stamped and log their visit, if they wish. As of this writing, the log-in register shows 41 visitors from elsewhere in the diocese have taken Holy Hours here and gotten their passport stamped! Pretty exciting, considering we are on the far east side of the diocese!

Church of the Holy Spirit Security Policy

Dear CHS Parishioners,

I want to update you on a new Nebraska state law concerning the carrying of firearms in our church buildings. The newly enacted state law allows adults to carry a concealed firearm without the requirement to complete the Concealed Carry Course. However, the law STILL requires that people receive the permission of the parish before they bring a weapon into our church or school property.

Therefore, according to Nebraska State Law, no one is allowed to carry any weapons, concealed or otherwise, without my approval as Pastor in the buildings of Church of the Holy Spirit and St. John the Baptist School.

Our parish maintains a security team consisting of police officers and a team of professionally trained individuals who have completed specialized training through the Church of the Holy Spirit Security Training Program. These individuals have been approved by me as of March 2023 and are the only individuals who are allowed to carry weapons in our church or school property.


