One Rose One Life On January 20th and 21st, the Knights of Columbus will conduct the annual "One Rose One Life" campaign, to support pro-life activities in Nebraska. The One Rose, One Life Campaign is the main source of income for the Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation. The major beneficiary of these funds is the Bishop's Pastoral Plan for Pro-Life Activities, as well as placing Ultrasounds in crisis pregnancy centers throughout Nebraska. Other worthwhile organizations that are provided with funding include: Right-to-Life and Birthright local chapters, crisis pregnancy help centers, the Pope Paul VI Institute as well as providing funds for March for Life pilgrims. After Mass, Knights will be hand out cards with a prayer to end abortions. Please read the prayer. Additionally, all proceeds from our free-will donation breakfast on the 21st of January will go to this outstanding effort. Finally, please continue to pray for the end to abortion.

Mass at Chapel of the Holy Innocents Fr. Timmerman will be offering a Mass at this small Chapel at 1101-1/2 Mission Ave, Bellevue, NE on Feb 3 at 11:00am. Nebraska Walk for Life January 27 in Lincoln. This event commemorates the Supreme Court decision that established a right to abortion across the United States, Roe vs. Wade, on January 22, 1973. That decision has since been overturned, but the Nebraska Walk for Life and other prolife events across the country continue, to remember the millions of lives lost because of abortion. It is the largest, longest-running First Amendment demonstration against abortion in the state.

Archbishop George J. Lucas will celebrate a 9am Mass before the walk at St. Mary Church, 1420 K St. in Lincoln. Msgr. Thomas Fucinaro, pastor of the Cathedral of the Risen Christ in Lincoln, will deliver the homily at the Mass.

The Walk then begins across the street at 10am on the north steps of the State Capitol, and goes to the Nebraska Union at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, 1400 R St. There, participants will find pro-life vendors, refreshments and fellowship. Melissa Ohden, founder of the Abortion Survivors Network, will be keynote speaker. Thousands of pro-life supporters have gathered for this event since its inception in 1974.






