Holy Sepulchre Cemetery guidelines for Spring Cleanup of decorations ◆Prior to the start of spring cleanup, all decorations from winter must be removed from graves by March 1st except those in permanent vases. No shepherd hooks, statues, figurines, eternal light, etc. are allowed from March through November unless they are permanently and correctly installed in the minimal 4" foundation ribbon of the headstone. Grave blankets are not allowed any time of the year. Our parishioners who maintain the cemetery grounds will clear out the above stated objects that should not be in the cemetery March-November. Before March 1st, please check any cemetery areas where you have placed decorations to make sure they are kept within the guidelines. If in doubt, please remove any objects, or call the rectory for clarification.

<u>Rosary Repair</u> In the Commons, Sundays of Lent (through Palm Sunday), before and after the Sunday 10:30am Mass. There will also be rosaries available for purchase, free-will donation. If you want to bring in a broken rosary during the week, please put it in a baggie, label with your name and phone number, and take it to the Rectory Office.

It was a great blessing to have so many of you attend our two "Town Hall" meetings on February 4th and 5th. Our Facilities Planning Committee has been working very hard these last few months with Clark & Enersen and Associates on the Facility Needs and Conditions Assessment, so it was very satisfying to see a large number of our parishioners respond with not only their presence, but also their engagement.

I really did not know how many people would come, and I was grateful that more than 150 people came to listen, ask questions, and give their opinions for both evenings. If you were not able to attend, I would encourage you to watch and listen to the recorded meetings now on our website. They can be found by clicking here on the online version of this letter: Facilities Planning | Church of The Holy Spirit (holyspiritplattsmouth.com) Please go to our website and then click on "Facilities Planning." You can also find the survey there, so please fill that out as well. We want as many parishioners as possible to provide their opinions. There are also hard copies of the surveys in the Commons if you would prefer to fill it out that way.

What are our next steps? We are going to collect all of the data from our surveys, and then use that to help us in strategic planning for our parish and school. This data will be made available for all parishioners to review in the coming weeks, along with the final Facility Conditions and Needs Assessment. I think that it will be important to find out what dreams and concerns our parishioners have, and then use that information as we create our next strategic plan. Additional "Town Hall" meetings will be scheduled to update the parish and gather more insight on the visions our parishioners have for both the school and parish community. Once we have that strategic plan in place, it can help us to guide master planning for the facilities too. As I said at the meeting, we want to hear from all of you, and that is why the survey is most important right now. Continued engagement from the parish will be essential in making this effort a success. Together we can set the foundation for a bright future!




