National Eucharistic Revival:

Have you heard? Leading up to a Nation-wide Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, IN July 2024, there will be 4 *gigantic* Eucharistic Processions, originating from the *North, South, East and West edges of the United States*, May 17 - July 16, 2024, all converging in Indianapolis for the 10th Eucharistic Congress.

The West segment will be near us on June 21. It will stop at the Cloisters on the Platte and we are invited to be there, *and then to walk in the procession* for the next five miles to the Holy Family Shrine, where the Diocese of Lincoln will transfer the Eucharist to the Archdiocese of Omaha.

Check out: <https://www.eucharisticpilgrimage.org/> for details regarding the various routes and stops that the Eucharistic Procession will be taking across the United States leading up to July’s Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis. The national office for the Eucharistic Revival has much more planned, but THIS part of one of the largest Eucharistic Procession ever undertaken, comes within easy reach of us!!!

The Diocese of Lincoln is in the heart of the “Junipero Serra Route” from the west. While no registration is necessary to participate, it can be **very** important to help them gauge numbers of how many people might attend the various sites. This link takes you directly to the registration page, with an explanation of each of the stops in our diocese: [Overview : Serra Route - Diocese of Lincoln : Blackthorn : Events](#). Click “Register” and it will lead you to registering for “subevents”, such as the Cloisters/Holy Family Shrine stops including the logistics of parking/shuttles, etc.

If you want to attend any events in the Archdiocese of Omaha, Diocese of Grand Island, or elsewhere, the first link has an interactive map, where you can click on a site, ask for ‘more information’ and it will take you to the registration page for that particular diocese.

Just as crowds followed Christ throughout his earthly ministry, our nation will process with our Eucharistic Lord over 6,500 miles—through cities, along highways, and past rural towns—on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress. June 21 gives us an opportunity to be a part of this historic and holy procession! Register for the walk, joining in at Cloisters on the Platte, and/or register to spend time in Adoration of Jesus at the Holy Family Shrine!
