Cemetery decorations placement: Decoration of graves for Memorial Day must be removed no later than 7 days after Memorial Day. This year: by end of June 3. Please also keep in mind that, with the exception of during the Memorial Day time-frame, shepherd hooks, statues, figurines, eternal light, artificial flowers etc., are not allowed from March through November, unless they are permanently and correctly installed in the minimal 4" foundation ribbon of the monument/headstone. No items are allowed in or on the ground. All live flowers, wreaths, etc., must be removed from graves as soon as they are withered or dried.


