### **National Eucharistic Procession:**

Have you been hearing about this in the news? Leading up to a Nation-wide Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana in July 2024, there are 4 *gigantic* Eucharistic Processions, originating from the *North, South, East and West edges of the United States*. The 4 Processions are already on the go! They began from their respective starting points on Corpus Christi Sunday and will converge in Indianapolis July 16<sup>th</sup> for the beginning of the 10<sup>th</sup> Eucharistic Congress.

**The West segment**, covering over 2,200 miles, will be the longest and arguably the most challenging of the four national routes. **And it will be near us on June 21<sup>st</sup>**. It will stop at the Cloisters on the Platte and we are invited to be there, ***and then to walk in the procession*** for the next five miles to the Holy Family Shrine, where the Diocese of Lincoln will transfer the Eucharist to the Archdiocese of Omaha.

The national office for the Eucharistic Revival has much more planned, but THIS part: Cloisters on the Platte to Holy Family Shrine, comes within easy reach of us!!!

The Diocese of Lincoln is in the heart of the "Junipero Serra Route" from the west. While no registration is necessary to participate, it can be **very** important to help them gauge numbers of how many people might attend the various sites. This link takes you directly to the registration page, with an explanation of each of the stops in our diocese: [Overview : Serra Route - Diocese of Lincoln : Blackthorn : Events](#). Click "Register" and it will lead you to registering for "subevents", such as the Cloisters/Holy Family Shrine stops *including the logistics of parking/shuttles, etc.*

If you want to attend any events in the Archdiocese of Omaha, Diocese of Grand Island, or elsewhere, the first link has an interactive map, where you can click on a site, ask for 'more information' and it will take you to the registration page for that particular diocese.

Just as crowds followed Christ throughout his earthly ministry, our nation will process with our Eucharistic Lord over 6,500 miles—through cities, along highways, and past rural towns—on his way to the 10<sup>th</sup> National Eucharistic Congress.

June 21 gives us an opportunity to be a part of this historic and holy procession! Register for the walk, joining in at Cloisters on the Platte, and/or register to spend time in Adoration of Jesus at the Holy Family Shrine!

Dear Parishioners,

It is good to be back this week after our diocesan priest convocation in Kearney, and then a few days of vacation after that. Thank you to both Fr. Pfeiffer and Fr. Bedient for covering the parish while I was away. The food was very good, I was able to get some rest, and even got in a few rounds of golf! It was a blessing to be with my brother priests at the convocation, and I think that we all gained much from both the fraternity and the talks from Fr. John Riccardo and his team from “Acts XXIX.”

As I told our strategic planning team at our meeting last Thursday, there were a few things I picked up from Father’s talks that I think we can include in how we approach our mission and vision as a Catholic parish and school, especially in the realm of Evangelization. First and foremost, prayer. Without prayer, without communication with the Blessed Trinity, we are simply carving out our own paths via our own plans. But if prayer is the most important thing that we as a parish (and individual parishioners) do every day, one of our intentions should be that we are seeking out *God’s plan* for our parish and school, and not our own.

As a parish, I think we have a good start in our 24/7 Perpetual Adoration. St. Paul said to pray without ceasing (1 Thess 5:17), and our Church of the Holy Spirit has a committed member or substitute praying in front of Jesus, the Blessed Sacrament, every hour of every day, minus of course the times Holy Mass is being offered. Not only is this a monumental work of dedication to our Lord, it is also a great service of charity to our parish and school. Incredible graces flow every day to our people because of this holy witness, and I am grateful to our parish coordinators and faithful prayer warriors who kneel down once a week, (and often times more), to adore, repent, petition, and give thanks to the God who loves them.

If Perpetual Adoration is one area where we are currently succeeding in prayer, where can we become even better at prayer? One area might be when we are asked to pray for someone who is sick. We are blessed to have our CHS Prayer Chain, where all of the sick and those in need of prayer are gathered together for us on one email. But what about the situation when we are asked in person to pray for someone? There is not one of us who would refuse that request; we say we most surely will. But can we do more? How about informing the person who asked us that we will be offering our next Holy Communion, or praying our rosary, or chaplet of Divine Mercy today for their intention? It can also be a very powerful witness to offer to pray for them right there on the spot in spontaneous, vocal prayer, invoking the Holy Spirit to give you the words to say in a prayer from your heart. An added bonus of praying with the person when asked is that you have immediately fulfilled their request to pray, and you don’t have to worry about forgetting to do it later.

I am grateful for all of the prayers you offer for our parishioners and their family and friends, and especially thankful for your prayers for me. I pray every day for you, that you will be the saint God wants you to be!

A tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar amount taxpayers claim on their tax return to reduce the state income tax they owe. A taxpayer will subtract the credit amount from their state income tax liability. This can lower a tax payment or increase a tax refund. For example, if your total tax liability on your return is \$1,000 but you claim a \$500 tax credit, your net liability drops to \$500.

These entities with state income tax liability can claim a nonrefundable tax credit for a contribution made to Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska (OSN):
