Please note that we have not arrived at the point yet for architectural "master planning" that would include illustrations and costs for possible new and/or renovated facilities. The master planning aspect is included in our strategic plan, but we first need a firm foundation and direction of where we believe God is desiring the parish to go regarding Catholic Worship, Education and Evangelization.

Eucharistic Revival *Passports!* report:

The Eucharistic Passport Program, a run-up to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana, began August 12, 2023, and now has ended! This was an opportunity for an individual to track his "pilgrimage" to 17 specific Churches or Chapels in the Lincoln Diocese, in order to have an Adoration Hour there. It was exciting for all to have this opportunity to make Holy Hours across our Diocese, and exciting for us that Church of the Holy Spirit was chosen to be one of the designated destination sites! The diocese has had countless comments from individuals saying how much they got out of the passport.

In our own Chapel, we had a sign-in notebook for all the pilgrims, both local from CHS, and those who came from other parishes. 151 people signed the notebook and stamped their "passport"!

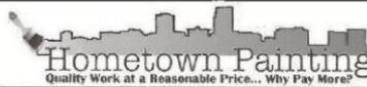
