Magnificat subscription re-order time. The Magnificat is a great way to enter into the daily Mass readings, as well as it having many nourishing and faith-building meditations. The current subscription for those who are receiving the Magnificat missalette with the parish bulk rate will end with December's issue. To renew or to newly subscribe for the year 2024, call Sue at the rectory office, 296-3139, no later than Monday, Oct. 7. The bulk rate is \$35.00 for the year, rather than its regular \$49.00 rate (make check out to Church of the Holy Spirit). These missalettes are sent to the church, for you to pick up there. Or put a note & money in a clearly marked envelope into Sunday's collection basket, or mail them in to the rectory office.

It's also time for "Living Faith" pamphlet renewal If interested in subscribing, at bulk rate (\$8.00/year), to the quarterly Living Faith pamphlet, contact Sue at the rectory office, 296-3139, by Monday, October 7. Subscriptions will run for all of 2024. As with the Magnificat, these will not be sent to your home; instead, you will need to pick them up at the rectory office. You can put a check for \$8.00, made out to Church of the Holy Spirit, in a clearly marked envelope via the collection basket at Mass or bring it to the rectory office.

MagnifiKid! - Time to renew or subscribe! (deadline: by October 7) This is a monthly publication similar to Magnificat, but for children 6 to 12. CHS is able to get a bulk rate on this IF we have a minimum of 10 subscriptions. Parents who would like to be in our bulk group subscription – please contact Sue at the rectory office, 296-3139, or email plattsmouthHSC@cdolinc.net by Monday, October 7, to let us know. Do not send in money yet - we need to first find out if we will have 10 subscribers! The annual subscription rate is \$18/year (which is less than half the regular price). You will receive 12 months from January to December 2024 (52 issues). Subscribers receive the issues on a monthly basis, to be picked up outside the parish office, just as the regular Magnificats are distributed. In each month's packet, children will find a booklet of sixteen color pages for each Sunday, and also special issues for the major feast days (Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, Ascension, Assumption, All Saints Day). Every week, MagnifiKid offers: All the readings and the prayers of the Sunday Mass with explanations of the difficult words and the meaning of the rituals; a **daily prayer** adapted from the Liturgy of the Hours; many suggestions on how to live the entire week with the Lord; various games, a comic, and activities to help children learn about Christian life and culture; a page intended for the parents with suggestions for family prayers. This can help: • to accompany them on the path of daily prayer; • to help them develop and nourish their spiritual lives; • to hand on to them our rich Christian spiritual values; • to encourage them to participate fully in the life of the Church. 
