That many Masses are then offered throughout the year for all those listed. This way, probably on a weekly basis, one of the priests' Mass intention will be for all these departed family members and friends.

The Traditional Latin Mass, also known as the Tridentine Mass, has been celebrated by the Roman Catholic Church for over a thousand years. St. John Henry Cardinal Newman noted that the Traditional Latin Mass is "virtually unchanged since the third century." In the sixth century, Pope St. Gregory the Great codified the Mass, especially "Gregorian" chant, which takes its name from him.

Mass of the Ages is a trilogy that explores the richness of the TLM through stunning cinematography and inspiring stories. But it's not just beautiful. It's also an investigation into the surprising events that led to the creation of the New Mass that is celebrated today.




