Some of you may know that long-time teacher at St. John the Baptist, Mrs. Sandy Rhoades, is retiring at the end of this school year. We are saddened that she is leaving us, but we wish her only the very best as she begins this new chapter of her life. Mrs. Melinda Hagerbaumer will also be leaving St. John's at the end of the year. She has been with us as our 4th grade teacher since the Fall of 2022, and we also wish her God's blessings in her new endeavors.

Sandy Rhoades has been and is an influential leader of young people, in teaching not only the secular subjects, but most importantly religion. It is clear from watching Mrs. Rhoades teach and interact with junior high students that the most important thing that she wants to communicate to her children is having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. That foundational relationship with God, that nothing else can replace, is lived out each day by prayer, study and the practice of the Catholic faith, especially through Mass and the sacraments.

Not only has Sandy been a strong advocate for children and the Faith, she has been a wonderful fellow teacher for our faculty members. She has been very helpful in assisting new teachers acclimate to St. John the Baptist, and has always been very willing to volunteer with different school projects. Her type of dedication to Catholic grade school education, especially here at St. John the Baptist, is unfortunately not as typical today as it once was, and we are very grateful to her.

Lastly, Mrs. Rhoades has been a tireless champion for the unborn and the pro-life cause, most especially by teaching her students the importance of cherishing every human life, from conception unto natural death. One of the blessings of a Catholic school education is the ability of our teachers to instill the Catholic faith in their students, not only in religion class, but in the non-sacred subjects as well, like Science, Civics and Literature. Sandy is a master teacher, able to weave our Catholic faith and defense of innocent babies into all subjects, not just religion.

While we begin our search for a new junior-high teacher, we are also beginning advertising for a newly created position from our Strategic Planning efforts. We are seeking a full-time Director of Advancement, Marketing and Communications position that would be responsible for the whole parish - both the church and the school. Currently, Mrs. Deb Walton fulfills this role, but only on a part-time basis, and for the school only, not the church side. She does a very good job for St. John the Baptist, but it became evident through months of strategic planning that this position needed to be expanded to cover the entire parish; both church and school. There are measurable goals that the church and school need to accomplish hand in hand over the next 5 to 20 years, and these strategic goals cannot be met without someone who is solely dedicated to the advancement and marketing of both the church and the school.

Again, I want to compliment Mrs. Walton for the great work that she has done for our St. John the Baptist school. She has also volunteered many hours for marketing on the church side, and her expertise there has been very helpful. While this part-time position for the school only is being eliminated in order to expand it for the whole parish, I want to thank Deb for being instrumental for many years in making sure that it is known throughout our community that St. John's is here and eager to teach the Catholic faith to young people.
