This past Tuesday, some of you received scam texts from someone impersonating me. The police have said that scammers are mining parish bulletins for the pastor's name and other cell phone numbers. That is why my name often appears as "Rev. Sean Timmerman" in the scam text you received, exactly as it is on the front page of the bulletin. I normally will only sign my name as Fr. or Father. I rarely use the formal "Rev." or Reverend. Below are some good reminders about protecting yourself from scammers.

#### - Fr. Timmerman

- · Look at the email address/text phone number of the sender not just the name that shows up in the message but look at the actual email address/text phone number to make sure that the sender is really who you think it is.
- · Always verify the person that is asking you for the money by another method. Calling them back and talking to them on the phone is the simplest way to verify that the email or text is or is not legitimate. But do not use a phone number that is in the email or text, rather, if it is someone you know, use your contact information to call them.
- Do not click on links in unexpected or suspicious emails. Do not scan QR codes in suspicious emails. Scammers can create these links and QR Codes to download malicious software to your computer and/or phone that can give them access to your devices and possibly bank accounts or other sensitive data. Only trust links and QR codes from emails that you were expecting and trust.
- Beware and stay calm whenever you get an unexpected request to send money. Scammers will try to get you worried or scared that something bad is going to happen. They want you to make a quick, rash decision to send them money / gift cards / scan QR codes or click on a link that gives them access to what they want. Do not fall for this.
