Dear Parishioners,

Happy Easter Week! I hope that you had the opportunity to spend some time with your family and friends on Easter Sunday, as we celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death in His Resurrection. We had a beautiful Sacred Triduum, even if it was interrupted for a little bit on Holy Thursday because of the storm! A first time for everything...

I am grateful to the parishioners who helped in preparing for the special liturgies. A lot of planning and organization went into last week, and we are thankful for our wonderful volunteers for all that they did in making sure everything was prepared and ready to go for the many different liturgies. I heard many comments from people saying how beautiful everything was for the Masses and liturgies.

Many parishioners also served as altar servers, lectors, readers, acolytes, and musicians for the different liturgies. Thank you for your dedication and offering of time and talent to the parish. Your humble service really made all our Masses and liturgies extra-special for the Lord on these most important solemnities for us Catholics.

I hope that you will be able to join us for the <u>Divine Mercy Holy Hour</u> on Sunday (April 27) at 2:30 **p.m.** We will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the availability of the sacrament of confession, special readings, private prayer, recitation of the Chaplet, and closing Benediction. This is a great way to prayerfully celebrate an important feast of our Catholic faith!

As we pray for the happy repose of the soul of our late Holy Father, Pope Francis, there are traditionally nine days of mourning a pope, called the *novendiales.* It begins on the day of his funeral, April 26<sup>th</sup>, and continues until May 4<sup>th</sup>. There are custom prayers for each day of a novena (nine days), as well as tolling the church bells and offering Masses for the late pope.

Here at Church of the Holy Spirit, we have black bunting over and around the main outside doors of the church. This black decoration is a symbol of mourning and honor for the deceased, and will be up until the end of the *novendiales*. We will also have available in church by the confessionals, special prayer cards for you to use and keep. One is a prayer for Pope Francis, and one is a prayer for his successor. Pray that the cardinal-electors give us a holy, wise and courageous Pastor of souls.
